

HOW DO I BOOK

A minimum of 24 hours notice is required for all bookings. You can do this in three ways :

- * At the Tourist Information Centre in Launceston
- * On line on our web site.
- * At your hotel.

Full payment is required at the time of booking.

If all seats are not taken It may be possible to still get a seat within 12 hours of departure, providing you phone us direct, if a seat is still available you will pay the driver.

PAYMENT METHODS

Most credit cards are accepted by our agents. However for Union Pay and EFTPOS you must be present at the time the transaction takes place. Direct credit is only available if booking more than 72 hours in advance.

MINIMUM NUMBERS

All our tours are subject to a minimum of 4 passengers on any journey. In the unlikely event that we do not receive sufficient numbers you will receive a full refund of any money paid.

CONCESSIONS

There are no special concessions available.



GETTING BACK TO THE BUS ON TIME

It is vital that you be back at the bus pick up points by the following times - our drivers can not go looking for you. Passengers must be back at either the main car park at 1515 (3.15pm) or Freycinet National Park Visitor Centre at 1530 (3.30pm). If you do not have a watch then ask other visitors. Please tell the driver where you would like to be picked up from at the end of the day.

If you do not speak English and providing you book as a group with a minimum of 6 people we will provide an interpreter/guide free of charge.

A National Parks Pass is included in the cost of the tour.

Optional fully guided side trips will be available or you can self guide and choose where you want to go.

You will have the opportunity to walk to the famous Wineglass Bay. Explore Honeymoon Bay, visit up to 5 different beaches, visit Cape Tourville Lighthouse and the Freycinet Marine Farm.

A interpretive map and notes will be provided to assist you in making a choice.

IMPORTANT

If you have paid for a return journey you can come back on the same day on our next visit or up to 7 days later, however, you must pre book your seat or there may not be one available.

DEPARTURE TIMES FROM LAUNCESTON

For logistical reasons it is not possible to pick up at your hotel or other accommodation, however upon return to Launceston we will drop off at a place of your choose providing it is within 4km of the city centre.

We have 7 pick-up locations starting in the outer suburb of Prospect: **0630** Country Club Casino; **0640** Village Family Motor Inn (Westbury Road); **0650** Hillview House, in upper George Street; **0700** St. Georges Square, (The Design Inn) at intersection of High Street and Ann Street; **0710** City Park, 13 Brisbane Street (Commodore Regent Hotel); **0720** Arthouse Backpackers (Lindsey Street); **0730** Brickfields Park, (Launceston Backpackers). It is vital that you are not late as we will not wait at these destinations, however please give our driver a call if we have not turned up at the allotted time.

RETURN TIME

You can expect to be back in Launceston around about **1830**. Drop offs will be in the reverse order from pickup.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL

Freycinet is generally a warm dry environment, but you should still bring a rain coat & a hat to protect from the sun. Footwear; some of the tracks are rough and steep in places, therefore sturdy supportive fully enclosed footwear is best. Flip flops or "thongs" are not suitable.

INFORMATION FOR BUSHWALKERS

If you intend staying overnight you will need to pre-book accommodation, unless you are camping at Wineglass Bay walkers camp site approximately 2 hours walk via Wineglass Bay Lookout or Hazards Beach Campsite, via western side of Peninsula approximately 3 hours.

It is wise to carry sufficient water as there is either no potable water at Wineglass Bay or only available after recent rain and Hazards Beach campsite is also subject to prevailing conditions. Seek advice from Rangers. Other accommodation options are paid camp sites at Richardson's Beach or Big 4 cabin park and private guest houses.

The National Parks web site has detailed information on what you can do and see in the Freycinet National Park. Bush walking; Overnight to four or five day walks are readily available. However, you need to be properly prepared. A tent(s) will be required. It is suggested that you buy your food supplies in Launceston prior to departing as there is limited shopping facilities at Freycinet.
